Access Statement for The Clothiers Arms

Introduction

The Clothiers Arms is a popular public house situated just outside the town of Stroud. We are a five minute taxi ride away from both bus and train stations. There is a slight hill to walk up if you are coming from the town centre.

We have a total of seven bedrooms, six en-suite and one with its own bathroom.

We have a comprehensive food menu, from light bar snacks to a full à la carte restaurant.

The bar is open all day everyday from 11.00am Monday to Saturday and 12 noon on Sunday.

Pre-Arrival

Alternatively, you can plan your journey by car or public transport using www.transportdirect.info ; simply enter your postcode and ours, which is GL5 3JJ, to get directions.
- The nearest railway station is Stroud which is 0.5 miles away (a 10-15 minute walk). Taxis are available at the station.

- The nearest bus stop is in the town centre. There is no bus service that runs passed the pub.
- The pavement on the street leading to the B&B is paved.

Car Parking and Arrival

- There is a large car park attached to the pub.
- It is level and tarmac. There is one disabled parking bay nearest to the pub entrance.
- The two entrances to the building have steps. The entrance to the bar is one step down.
- The entrance to the accommodation has three steps up. Although to access the restaurant requires the descending of 10 steps.
- An alternative way in to the restaurant is via the bar, although this will require going outside and down a steepish slope.

Welcome Area

- We do not have a designated reception area. Guests are asked to check-in at the bar.
- As stated, there is one step down on to a rush mat and a wooden/carpeted flooring

Bedrooms

- One twin room (not en suite) and one triple bedded en-suite are accessed via one and then three steps. The corridor is carpeted.
- The door to the ground floor bedrooms is 800mm/31.5ins wide, the other 2 are 750mm/29.5ins wide.
- Two other rooms have three wide steps up to them. Both are en-suite one being a twin and one a double.
- All other rooms require the use of a full staircase.

Bathrooms, Shower-rooms & Toilets (Ensuite or Shared)

- The twin room with a private bathroom is the largest and most easily accessed.
- There is no special equipment.
- There is a bath with an over shower.
- The flooring is linoleum
- There is a standard toilet.

Public Areas - Halls, Stairs, Landings, Corridors

- The one corridor is carpeted and has a doorway with door to open.

Public Areas - Lounge

- There is no private lounge area.

Public Toilet

- There is a public toilet in the bar area.
- There is no special equipment.
- The entrance is via a standard thirty inch door.

Dining Room

- Access to the restaurant area involves three wide steps through a set of retaining fire doors.
- The floor is tiled.
- The lighting on the lower floor is natural light via skylights.

- The upper level of the restaurant is accessed by three more steps on to a carpeted floor.
- Breakfast is served in the restaurant.
- Breakfast can be served in the bedroom by arrangement with management.

Garden

- A large level patio is accessed up a slope.
- Children's play area is via a bark chipped slope with 4 steps.
- Top lawn area is reached via 6 steps.
